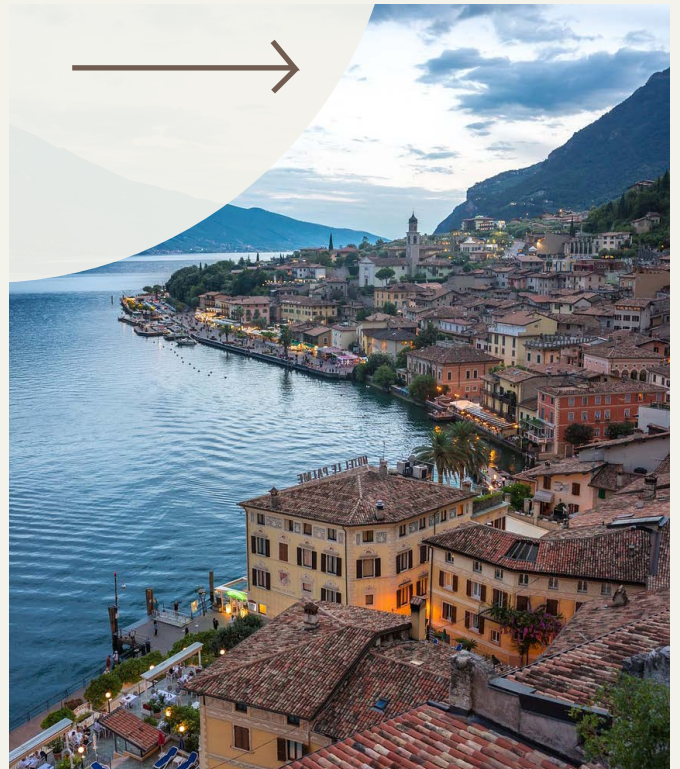

GARDONE RIVIERA (BRESCIA)

Why should you visit

It is famous for the Vittoriale degli Italiani and its retro charm.

Main attractions

- **The Vittoriale degli Italiani:** the former residence of Gabriele D'Annunzio, a fascinating place filled with memorabilia and gardens.
- **Heller Garden:** a botanical garden featuring exotic plants and art installations.

Recommended experience: an evening stroll amongst the historic villas.



ISOLA DI GARDA (BRESCIA)

Why should you visit

A private lakeside gem featuring a spectacular neo-Gothic villa.

Main attractions

- **Villa Borghese-Cavazza:** a stately home with elegant interiors and lush gardens.
- **Guided tours with tastings:** visitors can sample local produce.

Recommended experience: a tour with local wine tasting.

SALÒ (BRESCIA)

Why should you visit

It is an elegant little town with a charming lakeside promenade and a delightful old town.

Main attractions

- **Zanardelli Lakeside Promenade:** perfect for a stroll and enjoying the sunset.
- **Salò Cathedral:** a Gothic church with a Renaissance façade.
- **Palazzo della Magnifica Patria:** the historic seat of the Garda community.

Recommended experience: a romantic dinner at a restaurant overlooking the lake.



SIRMIONE (BRESCIA)

Why should you visit

Often referred to as the "Pearl of Lake Garda", Sirmione is one of the most romantic and charming towns on the lake, offering a blend of history, relaxation and breathtaking views.

Main attractions

- **Catullus's caves:** the ruins of a large Roman villa with terraces overlooking the lake.
- **Scaligero Castle:** a perfectly preserved medieval fortress with incredible views.
- **Sirmione Thermal Baths:** a sulphurous thermal spring ideal for a rejuvenating soak.

Recommended experience: a stroll along the lakeside promenade at sunset.

DESENZANO DEL GARDA (BRESCIA)

Why should you visit

It is the largest town on the lake and offers a lively atmosphere with restaurants, shops and a vibrant nightlife.

Main attractions

- **Villa Romana:** the ruins of an ancient villa featuring stunning mosaics.
- **Desenzano Castle:** medieval ruins with a breathtaking panoramic view.
- **Porto Vecchio:** a charming little harbour with cafés and traditional shops.

Recommended experience: an aperitif on the lakefront at sunset.



LIMONE SUL GARDA (BRESCIA)

Why should you visit

A picturesque village with historic lemon groves and spectacular views of the lake.

Main attractions

- **Limonaia del Castel:** an ancient citrus grove with incredible views.
- **Suspended walkway:** a panoramic footbridge overlooking the lake.

Recommended experience: try the famous local limoncello.

RIVA DEL GARDA (TRENTO)

Why should you visit

It is a paradise for sports enthusiasts, perfect for sailing, windsurfing and hiking.

Main attractions

- **Apponale Tower:** a viewpoint offering panoramic views of the lake.
- **Varone Waterfall:** a spectacular waterfall in a natural gorge.
- **Bastione di Riva:** a fortress accessible via a scenic funicular railway.

Recommended experience: windsurfing or sailing on the lake.



TORBOLE (TRENTO)

Why should you visit

A small town popular with surfers and nature lovers.

Main attractions

- **Torbole lakeside promenade:** perfect for walks and water sports.
- **Busatte-Tempesta scenic trail:** a hiking route with spectacular views.

Recommended experience: a mountain bike ride along the trails of Monte Baldo.



PESCHIERA DEL GARDA (VERONA)

Why should you visit

An ancient Venetian fortress surrounded by canals, perfect for history buffs and those who enjoy romantic strolls.

Main attractions

- **Venetian Fortress (UNESCO):** a perfectly preserved defensive structure.
- **Sanctuary of the Madonna del Frassino:** a place of worship nestled in the countryside.
- **Gardaland:** Italy's largest theme park.

Recommended experience: a boat trip along the canals of the historic centre.

MALCESINE (VERONA)

Why should you visit

A medieval village at the foot of Monte Baldo, perfect for sports enthusiasts and romantics.

Main attractions

- **Scaligero Castle:** a fortress housing a museum dedicated to Goethe.
- **Cable car to Monte Baldo:** a scenic ascent offering spectacular views.

Recommended experience: hiking or paragliding from Monte Baldo.



TORRI DEL BENACO (VERONA)

GARDA E PUNTA SAN VIGILIO (VERONA)

BARDOLINO (VERONA)

Recommended experience: visit local wineries for a wine tasting.

LAZISE (VERONA)

Why should you visit

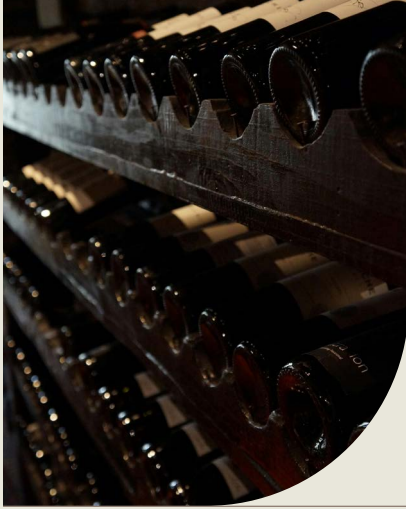
It is one of the most picturesque villages on the eastern shore of Lake Garda, with a well-preserved medieval old town and a lively atmosphere.

Main attractions

- **Lazise Harbour:** a picturesque little harbour surrounded by restaurants and cafés, perfect for an evening stroll.
- **Marconi Lakefront Promenade:** one of the most beautiful promenades on Lake Garda, offering panoramic views and direct access to the beach.
- **Garda Thermal Park (Villa dei Cedri):** an oasis of relaxation with thermal lakes set amidst nature.

Recommended experience: enjoy an aperitif overlooking the lake at sunset and visit the weekly market, one of the most renowned in the area.
